Overweight is defined as a BMI of 25 or more, thus it includes pre-obesity defined as a BMI between 25 and 30 and obesity as defined by a BMI of 30 or more.

Pre-obese and overweight however are often used interchangeably, thus giving overweight a common definition of a BMI of between 25-30.
